STALLS: ENQUIRIES AND BOOKINGS

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GENERAL INFORMATION

- Stalls are classified in two categories, which are applicable on both the food and non-food stalls.
- **Category A - “Professional” stalls**
Rent is charged for display area.
All profits are for the Lessee.
Receive 2 entrance wrist bands as well as 1 vehicle entrance permit – any additional tickets needed are to be purchased at normal price.
The purpose of these stalls are to have a variety to add to the charm of the festival.
- **Category B – “Community” and “Occasion” stalls**
No rent is charged for the display area.
All profits are for the festival (after deduction of expenses and costs).
The purpose of these stalls are to work for the “community of Christ” and contribute to projects in support of His work.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- **All food stalls must adhere to the laws, regulations and licences as required by the local and national government from time to time. For more information on this subject contact: Franslien Visser on 082 5577 683 or 022 931 2100 / 8460 at the Bergrivier Municipality. If the authorities close down a food stall for not complying to the laws, regulations and / or licences needed the risk will be only for the account of the stall holder and not the organisers.**
- **No vehicle movement by traders during the following hours:**
Friday: 17:00 - 23:30
Saturday: 12:00 - 23:30
Sunday: 09:30 – 11:30
Trespassing of this rule will lead to the immediate closure of your stand.
- The closing date for applications for stalls is **17 February 2012**. All payments must be made by **17 February 2012** and no refunds for cancellations.
- The displayer will limit his sales and activities to the display area allocated and will not disrupt or interfere with the activities of the festival.
- Each displayer will be **responsible for his own tent, gazebo, tables, chairs, umbrellas as required.** Only “low noise” generators will be allowed. The organisers will only supply a marked stand. The allocation and placement of the stalls will be done by the organisers and will be final.

- Each stall will only be supplied with electric lighting.
- A standard stall of 5m x 5m will be allocated to each displayer. Please specify on the application form whether an additional display area is required.
- The fee for a standard (5m x 5m) stall is R450 for the whole weekend. Should a bigger area be required, an additional fee of R25/m² will be payable. This additional request must be clearly specified on the application form.
- The area for the stall is available from Friday 9 March 2012. All stalls must be set up by Friday at 15:00 so that the electricity can be finalised and the organisers can inspect the terrain before the festival commences.
- **Should you wish to depart before the closure of the festival, it has to be after the last program on Saturday night or before the start of the program on Sunday morning**
- All stalls must be open at the following times

Friday	18:00 – 21:30
Saturday	09:00 – 21.30
Sunday	Stalls may not be open during the church service, only before and after the service.
- Nobody will be allowed access to the area without a valid permit. Entrance permits can be collected from the organiser or purchased at the entrance gate.
- No trader is allowed to erect their stall in a way which will endanger and/or hurt anybody.
- Fires may only be made in areas allocated by the organisers.
- Every trader is responsible to keep the area in and around his stall neat and tidy at all times and refuse must be removed daily.
- Vehicles may only be parked on the allocated areas for each stall owner. All vehicles must be removed before the commencement of the program.
- Only one vehicle is allowed per stall.
- No alcoholic beverages or beer is allowed to be sold or consumed.
- The organisers reserve the right to forbid products that are contradictory to the spirit and meaning of the festival.
- No trader will be granted the exclusive right for any product.
- Every stall must have at least one working fire extinguisher available at all times.
- The stalls may not be demolished before the electrical cables for lighting supplied by the organisers have been removed.
- All stalls must adhere to any local / national authority laws, specifically but not limited to health requirements.

- The lessee uses the premises at his own risk and indemnifies the organisers, as well as Hoërskool Porterville from any liability in the event of any injury, death, damage or loss of any kind.
- **Right of admission is reserved as well as the right of immediate eviction, without refunding of any fees, as a result of misconduct or the non-compliance of any of the terms and conditions**
